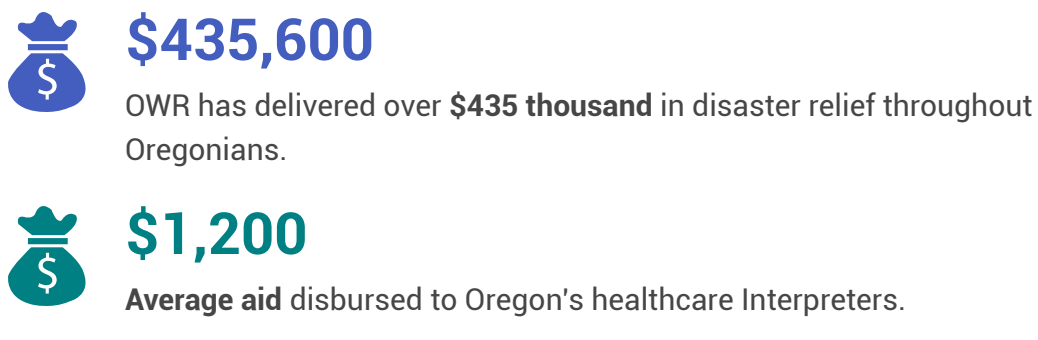




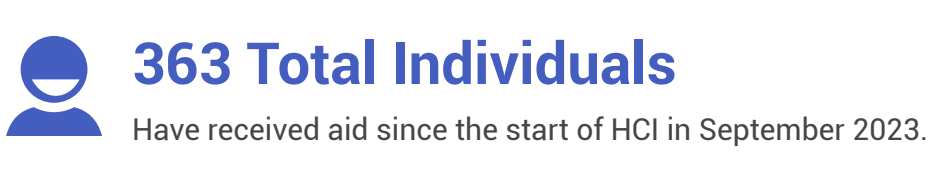
# HCI Report | September. 2023

## Amount Disbursed

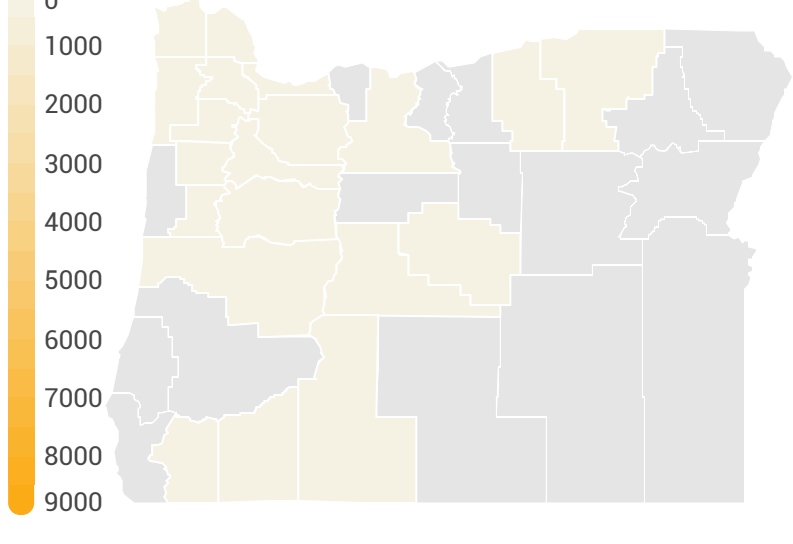


## Number of Recipients Who Received Aid

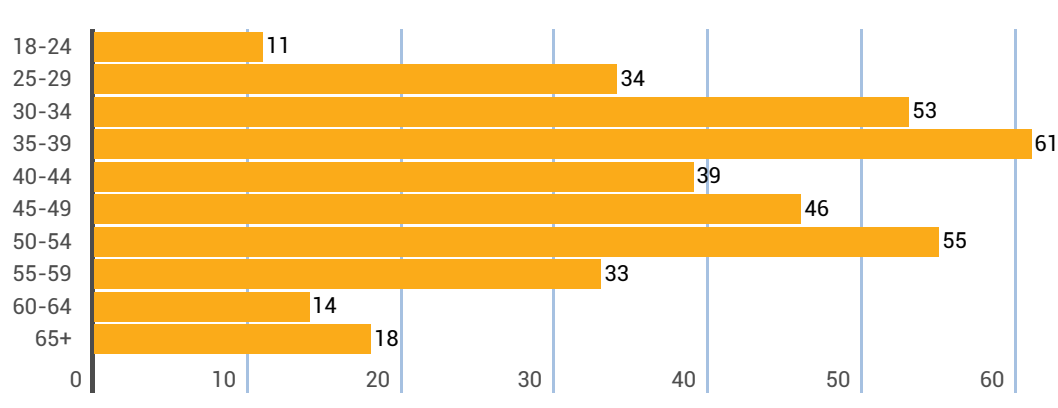


## Financial Relief Disbursed Throughout Oregon

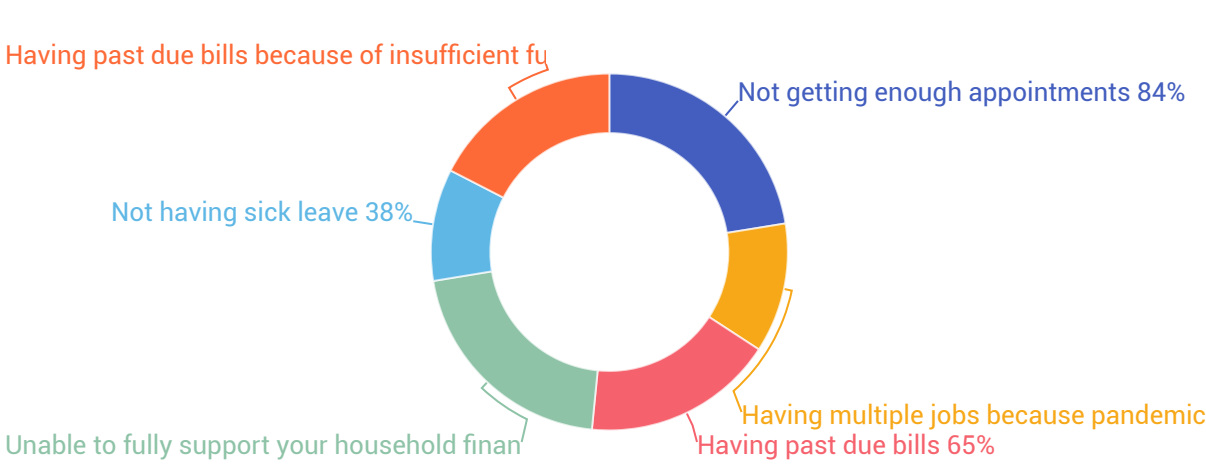
OWR's presence in Oregon is significant. HCI has provided financial relief in 22 counties in Oregon.



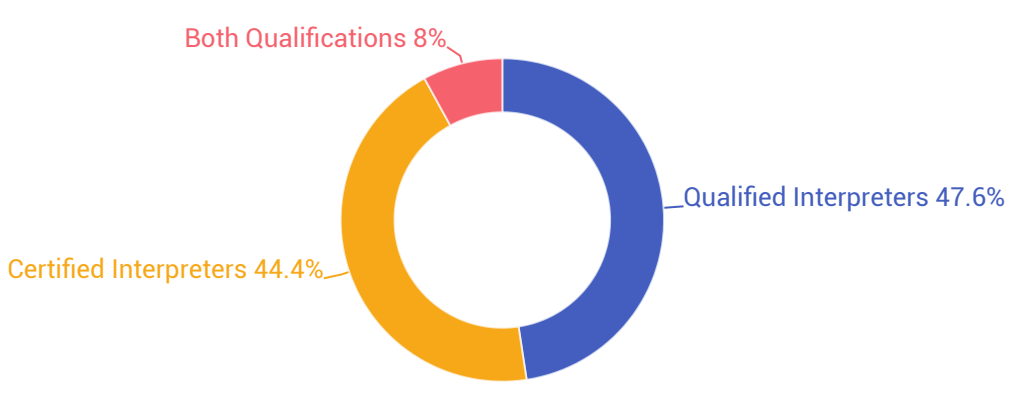
## Age Groups of HCI Recipients

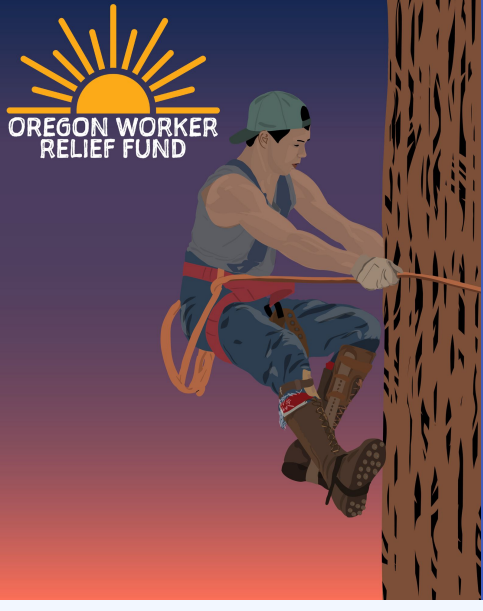
