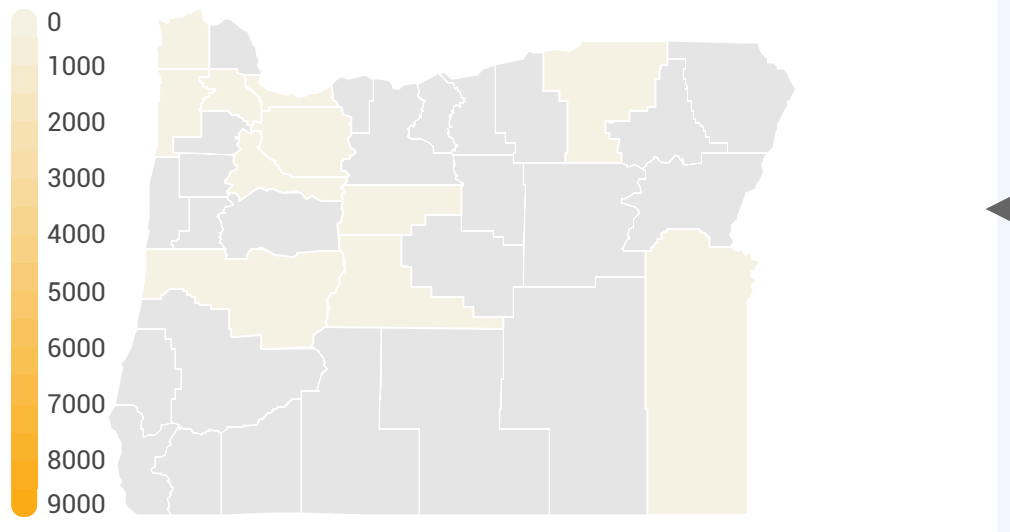

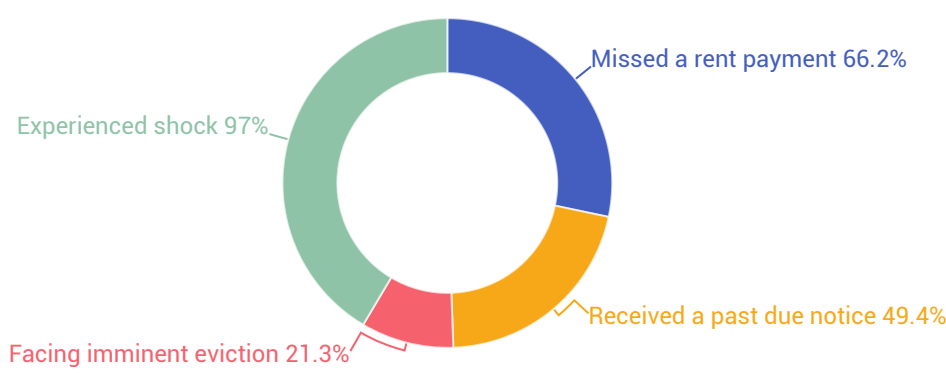

Financial Relief Disbursed Throughout Oregon

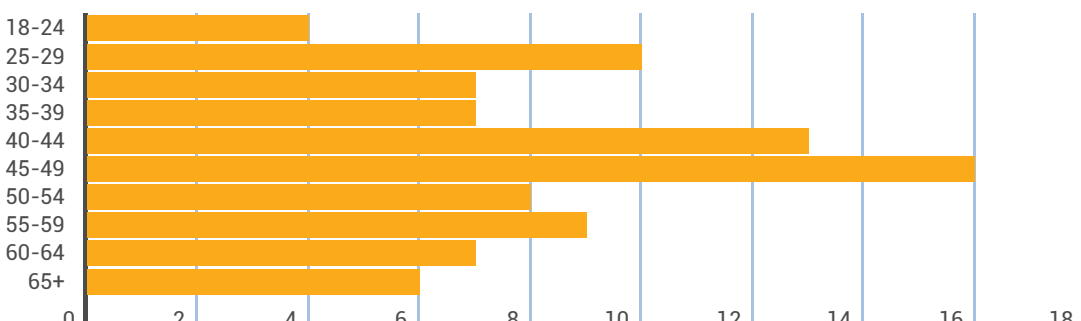
OWR's presence in Oregon is significant. Home Fund has provided financial relief to 11 counties in Oregon.



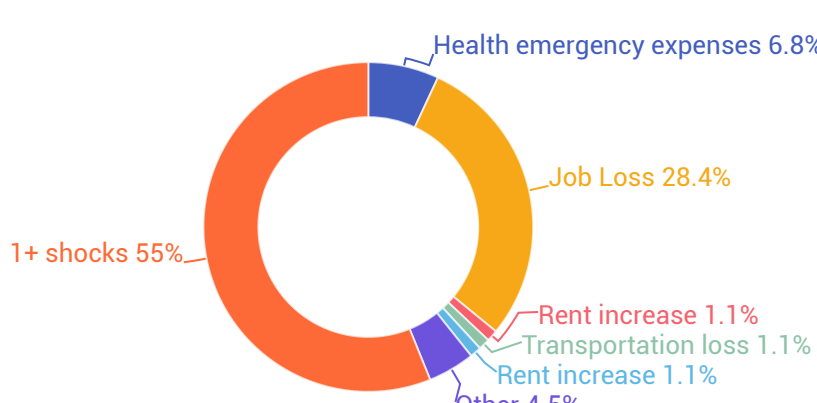
Challenges Home Fund Recipients faced
